Notice of Race

COMMODORE'S CUP - MONDAY NIGHT MADNESS - 'ROUND THE ROCK

1) RULES:

1.1 The races shall be governed by the Rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.

2) ELEGIBILITY and ENTRY:

- 2.1 Sailing vessels that meet NCPHRF minimum requirements are invited to participate.
- 2.2 Eligible boats must complete an entry form. The entry form is available on the club website and posted on the club notice board. The entry form may returned to:
 - a) through the BVBC website www.Bayviewboatclub.org
 - b) by mail: BVBC 489 Terry Francois Blvd. San Francisco, CA 94107 Attn: Race Committee or
 - c) by putting an entry form in the Race Committee envelope behind the Bar. Make checks payable to: Bay View Boat Club.
- 2.3 All entries must be received by the club by 18:00 on the Thursday before the day of the race but may be received up until the racing starts if approved by the Race Committee.

- 3.2 Each race will be one division and one start.
- 3.3 A boat that scores in the top 3 finishers of any Monday Night Madness series will be eligible to race in the BVBC Champion of Champions; See 3.1

4) SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

- 4.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available at the BVBC website www.Bayviewboatclub.org and on the BVBC notice board.
- 4.2 Changes to Sailing Instructions shall be posted on race day no later than 1000 for daytime races and 1600 before evening races.

5) SAILING AREA:

- 5.1 For Monday Night Madness races the sailing area shall be in the South Bay between SF Pier 54 and Alameda NAS #2.
- 5.2 For Commodore's Cup and 'Round the Rock races the sailing area may be the South Bay or in Central San Francisco Bay.
- 5.3 Courses shall be signaled from the Club Race Deck.

6) HANDICAPS:

- 6.1 Handicaps are the same as those of SF Bay YRA NCPHRF when known for a sailing craft or a Handicap assigned by the Race Committee.
- 6.2 The races will be scored on Time on Time.

7) TIME ALLOWANCES:

- 7.1 There will be a 6 Sec. per NM Time Allowance for Non-spinnaker and a 9 Sec. per NM allowance for Single Handing (no crew).
- 7.2 Any boat wishing a time allowance must so state on their Race Entry form.
- 7.3 A boats time allowance may not be changed during a series.

8) SCORING:

- 8.1 The Spring and Fall Series shall each be scored as a separate series with one throw out per series.
- 8.2 The Commodore's Cup and the 'Round the Rock Races shall be scored as separate events & shall not count towards the Club Championship.

9) AWARDS:

9.1 Awards for First & Second places will be given for each race of the Spring Series, Fall Series, and for the Commodore's Cup, 'Round the Rock and the Champion of Champions race.

10) DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY:

- 10.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race.
- 10.2 The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after any race.
